

Tree Lighting Security Overview

Join faculty, staff, students, alumni and community members for the Annual Christmas Tree Lighting Nov. 28 at 6:30-8:30 p.m. in the Campus Commons.

The clear bag policy in effect for football games will be used for this event. If you plan to attend the tree lighting, only the following items are permitted:

- Bags that are clear plastic, vinyl or PVC and not exceeding 14 inches by 14 inches
- One-gallon clear plastic freezer bags (Ziploc bag or similar)
- Small clutch bags, approximately the size of a hand, with or without a handle or strap with one of the clear plastic bags

Exceptions will be made for families with small children. Diaper bags and strollers are permitted. Bags may be checked at entry. Exceptions will also be granted for medically necessary items after proper inspection at the entry points.

Due to the amount of people and loud noises from the fireworks, pets are not permitted at the event.

The items listed below are not permitted:

- Coolers
- Chairs, including lawn chairs
- Glass bottles
- Drugs
- Alcohol
- Tobacco products
- Firearms
- Drones

TCU will inspect all bags brought into the event and reserves the right to remove any object from spectators if deemed inappropriate or unsafe.
